Sign Up Online

2. CREATE A FAMILY WORSHIP CENTER CHURCH ID

Go to fwcpc.org. If you have already created an account, just sign in.

3. GO TO THE MINISTRIES TAB AT THE TOP AND SELECT SPRING SMALL GROUPS

Login and select the groups you are interested in then submit. Prior to the first group meeting your host will contact you, typically through email.

Select the event and register by clicking on the ? by your name. Confirm.
